Beth Bronk, assistant professor; B.M., University of Texas at Austin; M.M. University of North Texas. Professor Bronk serves as Texas Lutheran University Director of Bands. Ms. Bronk earned The University of Texas Performance Certificate and studied trumpet with Ray Crisara. While at the University of North Texas, Ms. Bronk was a trumpet Teaching Fellow and studied trumpet with Keith Johnson and conducting with Anshel Brusilov. Ms. Bronk taught instrumental music in Texas public schools for 18 years and most recently held the position of Director of Bands and music administrator for New Braunfels I.S.D. During her tenure at New Braunfels, her bands earned statewide recognition multiple times as Texas Music Educators Association State Honor Band finalist and U.I.L. State Marching Band finalist. She was awarded New Braunfels I.S.D. Teacher of the Year and the Mirabeau B. Lamar Award for Teaching Excellence. Ms. Bronk currently teaches conducting, instrumental music education classes, and conducts the TLU bands. She also performs with the Prince Solms Brass Quintet and freelances in the San Antonio area. She holds memberships in the Texas Music Adjudicators Association, Texas Bandmasters Association, Phi Beta Mu International Band Fraternity, College Band Directors National Association, and currently serves as president of the Texas Music Educators Association Region 12. Ms. Bronk is an active clinician, adjudicator, and performer.
